### FOR EVENT SAFETY AND UNIFORMITY (CHECK ONLY ONE)

Yes, I will bring 40 rounds of black powder cartridges for the TWO battles or skirmishes each day.  
100 gr. Per Musket (60 cal. or larger) 70gr. Per Rifle (Up to 59 cal) 35 gr. Per Pistol (All calibers)

**Note:** Since most public carriers do not allow black powder aboard their vehicles, please notify us if you need black powder cartridges for the event(s) selected above. Possible arrangements can be made by notifying Event Coordinator, Ed Lunderman, at [thistle1996@hotmail.com](mailto:thistle1996@hotmail.com). I need cartridges for: Musket, Rifle, Pistol.

**Notice:** The following pertains to black powder firearms:

1. SALHA no longer provides black powder or paper on site for making cartridges.
2. If your weapon(s) are dirty or do not work, DO NOT bring them to the event
3. Weapon inspections WILL take place after you check in. Flintlock flash guards & frizzen stalls are REQUIRED.
4. Muskets or rifles are required to participate in battle reenactments. Pistols are only supplementary firearms.
